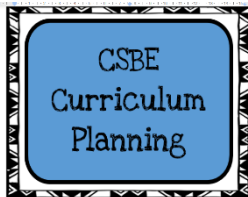

Learning Stations

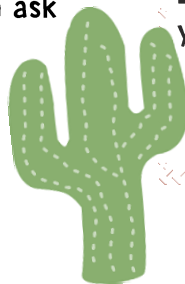

Guess Who – Human Version

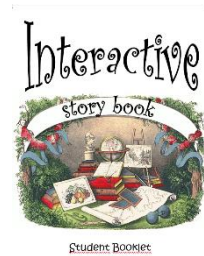
At this moment, Gabrielle Chabot is trying a "Guess Who" game – human version. You can ask her for feedback. [Here](#) are the documents she created.
