### English Day



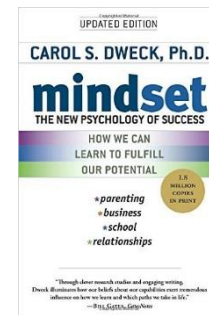

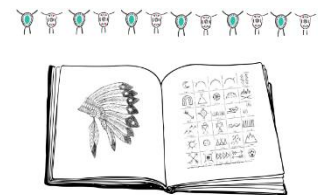
### The Growth Mindset

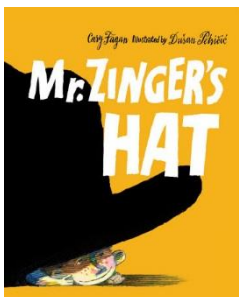
